## Making your bunting flag

Step 1: Choose your fabric – perhaps it could represent a link that you have to the hall.

Step 2: Cut out the bunting template and pin to your fabric. Cut out your first triangle.




Step 3: Repeat step 2, you will need two triangles for your flag.

Step 4: Put the good faces of fabric together and sew up the sides, leave the top part open.

Step 5: Cut off the excess fabric at the pointy tip. Turn out your flag so the good side is now facing out. Use a pencil or knitting needle to push out the pointy tip.

Feel free to be adventurous and add embellishments or embroidery your flag!
